

Grading Explained

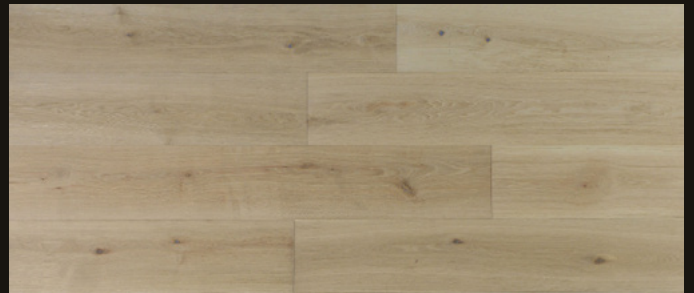
Prime Grade

- Grain is a variation of straight grain and medullary rays on boards
- Flat Sawn.
- No sap allowed.
- Occasional healthy pin knots up to max 10mm.
- Colour fairly uniform.
- No cracks allowed.



Light Character

- Grain is straight with natural grain variation allowed.
- Flat Sawn.
- No sap allowed.
- Healthy sound knots, (filled) allowed up to 45mm.
- Black knots allowed up to 20mm.
- No cracks allowed.



Rustic Grade

- Grain can be straight and wavy.
- Natural colour variations.
- Flat Sawn.
- No sap allowed
- Sound, healthy knots up to 60-70mm.
- Knots filled, all knots are small and not open.
- Black knots up to 30mm.
- End cracks allowed up to 10cm.
- Kissing Heart allowed.
